Which hand should I wear a golf glove on?

Your non-dominant hand plays the main role for both grip and control of the golf club. This means that right-handed golfers will normally wear a glove on their left hand, while left-handed golfers wear a glove on their right hand.

In some instances, you will see golfers with gloves on both hands or no glove at all!

What size golf glove should I wear?

Wearing a golf glove that is the incorrect size can have a negative effect on both the lifespan of the glove and also the control you have with the glove.

There are a few tell-tale signs for a glove that doesn't fit. If you are able to pinch substantial material on the palm or the fingers then it is too big.

A brand new golf glove should have a restrictive feel at first as it will loosen up within a few minutes.

Leather vs Synthetic?

Leather gloves provide a much softer feel compared to synthetic gloves which is the main reason why they are more popular among most of the tour professionals.

The downsides of leather golf gloves is they can tend to be more expensive than synthetic, but luckily for you that is not the case at Derbyshire Golf Supplies.
